TURNING THE WORLD UPSIDE DOWN

GROWING TOGETHER

 Share a moment from your early days as a Christian or in your faith journey that you now look back on with a mix of amusement and humility due to your "I want to turn the world upside down" energy.

GROWING WITH GOD

Read <u>Acts 17:1-9</u>, <u>Genesis 22:2</u>, <u>Isaiah 53:3-11</u>, <u>Psalm 22:1; 14-18; 31</u> aloud and go over your sermon notes with one another. (Answer all or some of the questions)

Acts 17:6 tells us that Paul and Silas were being searched for by "jealous Jews" because they were "turning the world upside down". They were saying things to anyone who would listen about the hope they have in Jesus Christ.

 Reflecting on the accusation against Paul and Silas, how can our lives as Christians today turn the world upside down for Jesus?

Paul returned to Synagogue three Sabbath's in a row according to Acts 17:2-3. He did three things - "he reasoned with them from the Scriptures, explaining and proving that it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead ..."

- How does Paul's determination to share the Gospel for three weeks straight inspire us to keep spreading the message of Christ, even when faced with challenges or rejection?
- What practical strategies can we adopt to develop toughness and endurance in our efforts to share the Good News?
- How can we improve so we have an answer ready for anyone who asks?

As one of the original Disciples of Jesus, Paul has a front-row seat to all of Jesus' teachings, miracles, actions, and events that will ultimately turn the world upside-down. Paul clearly understood what the goal was: to proclaim the Gospel as the story of the Messiah, to reason with anyone who would listen as to who Jesus was and what He had done for all people. Paul knew the Old Testament was the story of Jesus.

- How does understanding the significance of Jesus as the central figure in all of Scripture impact our approach to how we study the Bible?
- How does understanding Jesus' significance as the central figure in all of Scripture impact our approach when we explain the Bible to others?

We read in Genesis 22:2 how Abraham was told and not asked by God to sacrifice his son as a sign of obedience. This served as an example of a father's sacrifice of his only son for a greater and redemptive purpose.

- In what ways does Abraham's declaration, "God Himself will provide a lamb," align itself with the message of the Gospel?
- How does this statement reflect the nature of God's love and His ultimate plan for redemption through Jesus Christ?

GROWING IN OBEDIENCE & SCRIPTURE

Personal Bible Study Challenge: Commit to a personal Bible study challenge for a time-period you're comfortable with, focusing on discovering Jesus in every book of the Bible. Schedule a follow-up discussion to share insights and reflections with another member in the group for accountability.

Outreach Teams: Form small outreach teams within the group, tasked with identifying opportunities to share the Gospel in the community. However these opportunities are exercised, these teams can actively engage in spreading the message of Jesus.

Invitational Evangelism: Invite others to church, especially Easter services. Prayerfully identify individuals in your circles of influence who need to hear the message of Jesus and extend a personal invitation. Write at least two names down before leaving for the evening.

Here are the two insights Pastor Jason gave us:

- 1) Jesus is the central figure in all of Scripture.
- 2) The Gospel is the story of a loving God working to restore lost people to Himself through Jesus Christ.
- If someone is feeling the Holy Spirit stirring in their heart and they are being convicted to follow Jesus, lead them to salvation with the Sinner's Prayer. While this prayer is not in the Bible, slight variations of it are commonly used to lead someone to salvation through Jesus Christ.

Sinner's Prayer: Dear Heavenly Father, I know that I am a sinner and I ask for Your forgiveness. I believe Jesus died for my sins and rose from the dead. I turn from my sins and I repent from my sins. I invite you to come into my heart and my life. I want to trust and follow you as my Lord and Savior. In Jesus' name, Amen.


